
## HOW GARDEN HOSTS CAN DO A LIVE FEED in the Closed FACEBOOK GROUP – '2021 Virtual Sydney Edible Garden Trail'

## AFTER YOU'VE SET YOURSELF UP, WE SUGGEST YOU PRACTICE FIRST ON YOUR OWN FACEBOOK PROFILE BEFORE DOING ONE IN THE VSEGT Group


- 1. Make you're registered on Facebook
- 2. Login and search for '2021 Virtual Sydney Edible Garden Trail'
- 3. Request to join this closed Facebook Group (if you haven't already)
- 4. Let us know two date and time options of when you'd like to do your feed
- 5. It would also be great if you joined the SEGT Hosts page (if you haven't already). This is the group where we keep in touch with all our Garden Hosts.

## WHEN YOU'RE READY TO GO LIVE,

- 1. We'll change your member access in the group to 'Admin'
- 2. Go into the group and create a discussion post. Write something about your garden to give people an idea of what to expect. And select 'GO LIVE'



3. You'll then see a screen, like a video screen. YOU ARE NOT YET LIVE but you need to check that the camera is facing the right direction (not your face – unless you really want to do a tour of your face and not your garden). If the camera is facing the wrong way, press the button that look like a camera (the location of this will vary between android and apple phones)



- 4. Press 'Start Live Video', and you're off!
- 5. Some handy live video feed ideas
  - a. Go slow, don't zoom around it gives watchers vertigo
  - b. Focus in on different areas, features of the garden
  - c. Give people an idea of scale, mention how big the space is they're looking at
  - d. Zoom in close to some plants, features, points of interest

- e. If you feel confident, you can always swap the camera back to yourself for a little bit to chat to people
- f. Keep an eye on the comments coming in, say hi to people who've joined your live video, answer questions that come up
- 6. When you've finished, stop the video
- 7. There will be an option to save the video. Do it, that way you have it forever!
- 8. Be sure to go back into your post later, so you can respond to comments, add more information about specific elements you talked about etc etc.
